

RESOLUTION NO. 16-55

PUBLIC WORKS SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES

WHEREAS Bonner County operates a solid waste disposal system pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Code Title 31 Chapter 44; and

WHEREAS Idaho Code 31-4403 requires the Board of County Commissioners in each county to acquire sites or facilities, and maintain and operate a solid waste disposal system; and

WHEREAS Idaho Code 31-4404 provides that each county may finance solid waste disposal facilities by user fees, taxes or other appropriate charges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution 14-67 is rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Bonner County Board of Commissioners, that the following fees and requirements are hereby established:

RESIDENTIAL

1. Residential solid waste disposal fees shall be calculated as set forth in the attached "Schedule A" and will be effective July 19, 2016.
2. A residential solid waste disposal fee in the amount of \$105.00 per year is hereby established for each occupiable dwelling unit in Bonner County.
3. All property owners who pay the required \$105.00 fee shall be issued two (2) facility stickers for each solid waste fee applied. Stickers must be used in order to dispose of debris at the Bonner County Solid Waste Transfer Stations. Contact the Public Works office for additional stickers at 208-255-5681 ext. 2.
4. Two (2) additional stickers for a total of four (4) stickers will be provided at no charge; additional stickers over four (4) will be charged \$5 each.
5. Landlords are responsible for distributing the issued stickers to their tenants.
6. Property management companies requesting stickers will be charged \$5 per sticker.
7. Solid waste disposal fees may be applied and collected as residents apply for Building Location Permits. Property owners would do this to have access to the transfer sites for disposing of household trash while building a dwelling.

8. Any household qualifying for "Circuit Breaker" relief on their 2016 property tax bill shall be billed in accordance with the attached "Schedule B" which is hereby incorporated into this Resolution in its entirety. Furthermore, property with a residential usage in a non-permanent structure will be assessed a residential fee as determined by establishment of utilities, and/or addressing, and/or contributing space for residential use.
9. Bonner County residents applying for solid waste stickers will be charged \$105.00. Stickers are valid for a calendar year; from January 1st to December 31st. Stickers purchased as of July 1st or later will have an adjusted rate of \$52.50.
10. Out of county users applying for a solid waste sticker will be charged \$250.00. Stickers are valid for a calendar year; from January 1st to December 31st. Stickers purchased as of July 1st or later will have an adjusted rate of \$125.00.
11. Stickers are for the disposal of household trash only and are not to be used for any commercial disposal. (See commercial section below)
12. Use of an unattended site without a sticker shall be classified as a violation and will be subject to the penalties as described in Bonner County Solid Waste Ordinance No. 212.
13. The Solid Waste Department is responsible for determining if a load is acceptable. Certain types of debris or hazardous materials may be referred to another facility.

COMMERCIAL

1. Commercial solid waste disposal fees shall be calculated as set forth in the attached "Schedule A" and will be effective July 19, 2016.
2. As per Bonner County Code Title 7-202 and the Idaho Constitution, Article XII Section 4, a county approved solid waste disposal and collection system must be used by all commercial, non-profit and public entities.
3. All commercial, non-profit and public establishments in Bonner County including but not limited to motels, hotels, resorts, automobile repair garages, churches, schools, office buildings, recreational vehicle parks, restaurants, campgrounds, bars, taverns, grocery stores, gas stations, retail stores, and commercial buildings shall have their municipal waste collected by an authorized commercial hauler. The frequency of collection for commercial and public establishments shall be such that a public health hazard or nuisance does not result. (Ord. 212, 1-9-1992)
3. Mobile/RV Parks in Bonner County must arrange with the current waste disposal contract holder, a collection system that is suitable to the size and number of spaces within their park. If you have questions contact Bonner County Solid Waste Department at 208-255-5681 ext. 2.

4. The Solid Waste Department is responsible for determining if a load is acceptable. Certain types of debris or hazardous materials may be referred to another facility.
5. All commercial fees billed pursuant to this Resolution shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days of the invoice date. Past due accounts will be subject to suspension and/or cancellation.

SOLID WASTE FEE SCHEDULE
FY16-17

RESIDENTIAL

Customers with a solid waste sticker may dispose of up to six (6) yards per day at no charge, any overage will be charged at the posted commercial rates. Customers without a sticker pay \$5 to dispose of one yard or less and \$5 each additional yard up to six (6) yards; over six (6) yards will be charge at the posted commercial rates.

Hazardous household waste (paint, oil etc.) is limited to five (5) gallons per day and must be in spill proof, sealed containers. The Solid Waste Department reserves the right to determine if a load is acceptable. Certain types of debris or hazardous materials may be referred to another facility. Customers without a sticker may pay \$5.00 to dispose of up to 5 gallons of household hazardous waste.

Appliances with freon (i.e.: refrigerator, freezer)

First two (2) of the same kind	\$ No decommissioning fee
3 rd appliance or more	\$ 30.00 decommissioning fee per unit

Tires:

Passenger auto or pickup	\$ No charge for the first eight (8)
The 9 th passenger tire or more	\$ 3.00 each
Large truck (semi-truck or trailer)	\$ 10.00 each
Oversized (skidder or farm tractor)	\$ 35.00 each
Dead animals less than 100 lbs.	\$ No charge
Dead animals 100 lbs. or over	\$ 10.00 each

COMMERCIAL

The Solid Waste Department reserves the right to determine if a load is acceptable and apply the cost to process the debris if there is a question as to content, weight, and/or amount. Certain types of debris or hazardous materials may be referred to another facility.

Minimum charge on ½ yard or less	\$ 6.00
Commercial inert waste	\$ 6.00 per cubic yard
Commercial waste	\$ 12.00 per cubic yard
Commercial waste by weight	\$100.00 per ton (\$0.05 per lb.)

Televisions under 75 lbs., computer monitors	\$ 15.00 each
Televisions over 75 lbs.	\$ 25.00 each

LED televisions and rear projection televisions are not recyclable and are to be placed into the noramal waste stream.

Tires:

Passenger auto or pickup	\$ 3.00 each
Large truck (semi-truck or trailer)	\$ 10.00 each
Oversized (skidder or farm tractor)	\$ 35.00 each
Dead animals less than 100 lbs.	\$ 10.00 each
Dead animals over 100 lbs.	\$ 25.00 each
Refrigerators / Freezers	\$ 30.00 decommissioning fee per unit

Re: Solid Waste Resolution Establishing Fees for 2016-2017

The attached resolution is provided for your review and has been revised to establish Solid Waste fees for 2016-2017, effective July 19, 2016.

Noted changes:

- Residential: dead animals over 100 lb. was \$25 each; now \$10 each
- Commercial: minimum fee was previously \$5 for less than ¼ yard; now \$6 per ½ cubic yard
- Commercial: waste by yardage \$13 per cubic yard; now \$12 per cubic yard
- Tires large truck \$12 each; now \$10 each
- Tires oversized \$37.50 each; now \$35 each
- The \$105.00 Residential Solid Waste fee after July 1 will be prorated to \$52.50 for the remainder of the year
- The \$250.00 Out of State Solid Waste fee after July 1 will be prorated to \$125.50 for the remainder of the year
- \$105 sticker fee provides 2 stickers and we will provide 2 additional stickers at no charge; additional stickers after the 4th will be charged \$5 each.

Whenever there is an increase that exceeds 5% a hearing may have to occur; we are proposing no fee increases and several fee decreases.
