Re: Lightbar donation to Shoshone County EMS



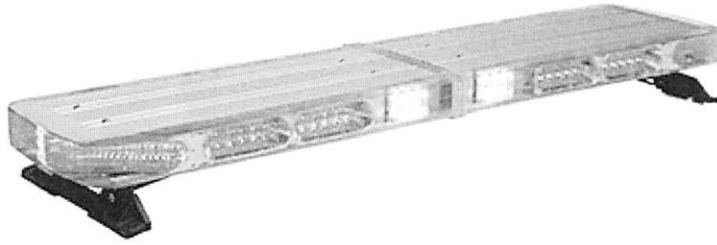

Donation of County Property to Shoshone County EMS

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 31-808(9) and IC 67-2322, the Board of County Commissioners may at their discretion, grant to or exchange with the federal government, the state of Idaho, any political subdivision or taxing district of the State of Idaho, with or without compensation, any personal property owned by the county when it is in the best interest of the public in the judgment of the governing body of the granting unit; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County EMS has a “Liberty II LED Lightbar”, valued at approximately \$350.00 which they no longer have a use for; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it would be in the public’s best interest to grant the “Liberty II LED Lightbar” to Shoshone County EMS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Bonner County EMS have determined that the County no longer has a need for a “Liberty II LED Lightbar” and hereby grant the lightbar to the Shoshone County EMS.
