Road Name Change**

**WHEREAS**, Title 13: Bonner County Road Naming and Addressing System Ordinance, Chapter 5: Enforcement and Administration, allows for the Bonner County Address Administrator to bring forward before the Board of County Commissioners any disputed road name, addressing issues, or controversial road name changes for approval or resolution, and;

**WHEREAS**, In January 2017, communication began between the County and constituents regarding property addressing and road naming in the Sagle area, and;

**WHEREAS**, On May 4, 2017 a notice was sent to the property owners and/or contract buyers of properties informing them that Haystack Ln was the name that had been assigned by the former Address Administrator and unless there was no adverse response within 30 days, would be officially named, and;


**WHEREAS**, at this point conflicting information exists between the County and the constituents involved, forcing the current Address Administrator to bring the issue before the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Bonner County Ordinance Title 13, Chapter 5 Enforcement and Administration.


