WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 and § 31-808 vest the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County Public Works is in possession of the following vehicles: 2006 Chevrolet Silverado Pickup VIN: 1GCHK24U16E163354 and 2006 Chevrolet Silverado Pickup VIN: 1GCHK24U16E163306; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County Solid Waste is in possession of a 2003 Ford Pickup F550 VIN: 1FDAF57P93ED82440; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County Public Works and Bonner County Solid Waste desire to have the vehicles declared as surplus to their operation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Idaho Code Title 31 Chapter 8, the Board of County Commissioners determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Bonner County to transfer the equipment described above to Bonner County Facilities & Recreation.



The foregoing was duly enacted as a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho, on the 5th day of July, 2017.


