### **Neighborhood CO-OP Program, in a nutshell:**

- \*Provides financial assistance to landowners controlling noxious weeds by reimbursing the landowner(s) for the cost of quality herbicides.
- \*Amount reimbursed ranges from ~60% - 100% depending on funding availability [it is typically different each year]
- \*Program is primarily funded by an Idaho State Department of Agriculture grant, and is supplemented by Bonner County.
- \*Program is open to private property owners controlling noxious weeds for the following uses: on personal farms or pastures [for personal use], around homes / outbuildings / barns / vacant lots, on privately maintained Rights-of-Way, and on common areas in Homeowner's Associations.
- \*Program is NOT open for the following uses: commercial farms, on corporate timber land or government land, or for monetary gain.
- \*Minimum of 2 landowners needs to be signed on
- \*Sign-up packets are usually available starting in March or early April
- \*Completed applications are due back to the Weeds Department for processing by May 31<sup>st</sup>
- \*Herbicide receipts and spray report are due to the Weeds Department by August 31<sup>st</sup> for reimbursement in October.
