



# When an Injury Occurs at Work

## Bonner County Protocol

### 1. Immediately Report Your Injury:

- Report your work injury or accident to your supervisor.
- Complete the Workers Compensation Claim Form, and send to Bonner County HR/ Risk Dept. (<http://bonnercounty.us/risk-management/>)

### 2. If you need to see the doctor:

- **Bonner General Hospital Occupational Health** is the Designated Medical Provider for Bonner County. 520 Third St, Sandpoint, ID. 208.265.1284. Open M-F 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.



### 3. The following locations may be used if you need emergency medical care after hours:

### 4. Work Restrictions and future scheduled appointment(s) will be given to the injured employee after each evaluation. Bonner County will try to reasonably accommodate work restrictions to avoid lost time injury cases.

Under Idaho Worker's Compensation system, the employer may assign a medical preferred provider for treatment of the injured worker.
