<b>Other Common Herbicides/Surfactants:</b>

**For All Herbicide Applications Use:**

Surfactants (Induce, Dynamic, Ad Spray 90) at 1 qt. per 100 gallons of solution.

**\*Always read the product label before mixing**

\*Be sure to read any caution statements pertaining to safety and other nearby vegetation.

\*The herbicides suggested as methods for control are known to work very well in Bonner County when applied properly. It is important not to guess and to be certain of what you are trying to do for success.

\* Other methods of controlling weeds, with or without herbicides are optional.

\*Please call the Bonner County Weed Supervisor if further assistance is needed.

\***Always** add a surfactant as a sticker or adjuvant to these herbicides.

\***Never use soaps or detergents for adjuvant or spray sticker** since it could reduce proper control. Use a known spray additive to increase adhesion, absorption and residual properties of chemicals.

\*The addition of 2,4D at 1 Qt. per acre will increase effectiveness of many products and especially Common Tansy products.

\*The use of just 2,4D on many of seedling weeds, less than 4" high, can be effective but several applications, once a month, may be necessary.

\*For "bare ground" applications, products like Roundup plus 2, 4-D work well, but also kills grasses. To keep weeds from coming back quickly, grasses are the best competitors.

\*Does the job appear expensive? Don't use less product, just control the amount of weeds you can afford each year. When the product is applied properly the first time, it usually reduces the need to treat the same area every year. Not enough chemicals per acre gives partial to poor control for the money and time spent.

\*Apply most products in 20 gals. of water per acre or more, but check the label to be sure.
