LANDOWNER'S AGREEMENT

The Selkirk Cooperative Weed Management Area members, which include several agencies, such as Bonner County, U.S. Forest Service, Idaho Department of Lands, and other organizations, need your support in controlling weeds on your land. Grant funds for this project are available and your approval is requested.

Please sign this form to provide us documentation that we may cross your land and treat the targeted weeds as needed. It's our intention to ensure the actual property owner has been notified and is in favor of the activity proposed. This agreement is very necessary for renters and neighbors of those owners who may live out of the area.

The weed management area members who have organized this effort also request the landowner make plans for future treatment of targeted weeds. It's extremely important that these weeds be prevented from going to seed avoiding the high costs of control. The cost of spot treatments for a few years is far less than this treatment. State law requires the landowner to be responsible for all costs of weed control and this is an opportunity for you to receive assistance in reducing those costs.

This agreement only applies to those weeds identified on this form as the targeted weeds. Please return this form within 7 days to the above address or call our office if you need assistance or more time to respond.
